Mr. Holden (for himself) presents the following resolution:

A Joint Resolution

It is the purpose of the LOOK UP (Large Overall Operations Keep Us Prepared) Bill to protect the Earth and its people from deadly falling asteroids.

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives assembled that the federal government will fund a massive offensive NASA and military mission to destroy the deadly Dibiaski comet that is on a direct path to hit the Earth in approximately 6 months.

- 1 Section 2: For this bill, the following definitions apply:
2 Comet Dibiaski - a 9 kilometer comet currently believed to be on a path to hit Earth in approximately 6
3 months according to calculations by NASA's Near-Earth Object Wide-field Infrared Survey Explorer
4 mission.
5 Defense Production Act - a law allowing the President significant emergency authority over domestic
6 industry
7 Earth - although the asteroid is projected to hit one area of the Earth, the catastrophic fallout would be
8 so widespread that all of Earth would be affected.
9 NASA -The National Aeronautics and Space Administration
10 Near-Earth Object Wide-field Infrared Survey Explorer (NEOWISE) mission - a NASA designed and
11 funded project to survey our skies for dangerous or even fatal asteroids

13 Section 3: Project Requirements
14 A. This bill allows NASA the funding and freedom to expand the NEOWISE mission to create a
15 plan to either destroy the Dibiaski Comet or nudge it out of its orbit.
16 B. This bill allows the President the full use of the Defense Production Act to put all necessary
17 resources available to the NASA NEOWISE mission.
18 C. This bill instructs the military to focus all resources and abilities toward the NASA NEOWISE
19 mission.

21 Section 4: Funding
22 A. This bill allocates 65 trillion dollars to the NASA NEOWISE project to develop a
23 comprehensive plan to destroy this deadly asteroid.

25 Section 5: Enactment Date - ASAP
26 A. This bill should be enacted immediately and without delay.
